Independence House Services

Counseling & Advocacy

Short-term crisis counseling, safety planning, resource assistance, specialized support groups.

Domestic Violence: Individual counseling, advocacy and groups for survivors of domestic violence, specifically intimate partner violence.

Sexual Violence: Individual counseling, advocacy and groups for survivors of: rape, incest, stalking, sexual harassment, molestation, childhood sexual assault, intimate partner sexual abuse. Counseling is available for survivors of all ages and genders, as well as partners, families and friends.

Child Witness to Violence: Individual counseling, advocacy and groups for children affected by intimate partner violence.

Teen Program: Individual counseling, advocacy and groups for adolescents affected by intimate partner violence including sexual violence.

Safe & Sound

Childcare program available at Hyannis office upon request.

Safe Home

Support and assistance with finding shelter. Emergency lodging available Friday 5 PM – Monday 8 AM.

Housing Stabilization

Supportive and stable housing for families affected by domestic violence (not in immediate crisis).

SAFEPLAN

Providing assistance and support in applying for a restraining order (209A) in probate/family or district court.

Medical/Police Accompaniment

Support and advocacy for sexual violence survivors at the hospital or police department.

Prevention, Education & Outreach

Prevention: Creating a culture free from intimate partner violence through primary prevention practices.

Education: Preventing or responding to domestic and/or sexual violence through trainings and workshops.

Outreach: Building awareness of domestic and/or sexual violence, and presenting agency services.
